- If you do not establish these at the beginning of a study with a non-Christian, you are quite likely to come here sooner or later!
- Who is the author of the book?
- To whom was it primarily written?

The reason these are critical is that many people will try to dissuade you from speaking about baptism by referring to many scriptures subsequent to the gospels and the Acts of the Apostles. If someone wants to learn more about becoming a Christian, go directly to the examples of conversion!

Examine a few examples of how this is fundamental to our understanding the overall message. Suggested books are Acts & Galatians.

***5. Inspiration of the Bible**

Mt 10:19-20, Lk 1:68-70, ICo 14:37, Gal 1:8-9, Gal 1:11-12, ITh 2:13, ITi 3:16, IPe 1:21.

What is the definition of inspiration? What is the significance or purpose to us?

Who or what inspired the Bible?

Compare w/Jn 1:1,14. Isn't it Jesus? Explain.

How do we know that the Bible has been divinely inspired, other than the Bible claims themselves?

What of modern miracles? (more about these later, #24) Mormons claim to be angels incarnate. They also claim to have a new revelation. What does Paul write about this?

***6. Authority of the Bible**

1. Not to add to nor take from it - Dt 4:2, 12:32, Pr 30:5-6, Ecc 3:14.

2. The final revelation - Jn 16:13, Gal 1:8-9, IPe 1:3.

3. Compare Jn 1:1-2, 14 with IJn 1:1-4.

See also "Other Religions" & "False Teachers," Num 24:12-13, Dt 4:2, 18:20, Pr 14:12, Lk 16:15,

ITi 3:16, Rev 22:18-19.

There are serious warnings and consequences for false teachers. Compare, again, with the "scriptures" of Mormons, Jehovah's Witnesses, Muslims, etc. Do they believe the Bible to be inspired? Why not believe it then!?

What is the origin of the gospel? cf Gal 1:11-12

Compare Jn 1:1,14 with 2Pe 1:21

*** These 3 are absolutely critical in establishing a proper foundation for study! Discuss.**

7. The Old Testament (for Jews - Under Law)

1. For our learning - Ro 15:4, Col 2:17, Heb 10:1.

2. Made known at Sinai - Neh 9:13-14.

3. Sabbath to Jews - Dt 5:2-3, 15.

4. Changed – Jer 31:31-34, Mt 26:28, Eph 2:13-15, Col 2:14, Heb 7:12; 8:7-8, 13; 10:9.

5. Ended at the death of Christ – Isa 2:3, Gal 3:19; ???16, 24-25; 5:4, 18, Heb 9:15-17.

6. Warnings against Judaizing – Gal ????, Col 2:14,16.

Are we still under the Old Law today? Defend. What was its purpose?

What of those who would cling to the Old Law? e.g. Churches of God still bind the Sabbath? Holy Weeks.

Are we under any law or covenant? Defend.

8. The New Testament (for Christians - Under Grace)

1. Christian era only after the death, burial & resurrection - Jn 16:13-14, Jn 14:26, ITi 2:15, He 8:6-13, 10:12.

2. People will inquire about the thief on the cross – how will you respond?

3. Do you see the importance of establishing point (theme) 7 before moving on to this point? Discuss... See also "The Old Testament," "Grace," "Holy Spirit," "Conversions," "The 11 Fulfilled Prophecies."

So...under what law or covenant did Christ live?

If you believe that faith alone does not save, how will you respond to inquiries as to the thief on the cross?

What is meant by "rightly dividing" the word?

As a matter of review, and relative to what we know about rightly dividing the word, discuss the significance of establishing those basic facts about whichever book of the Bible you may be studying.

9. Sin & Man’s Lost State

3. Sin is not inherited - Eze 18:20, Mt 18:3, Mk 10:13-15, Ro 14:12.

Does this mean you & me? What are the wages (consequences) of that sin?
Do I not have original sin, a.k.a. the sin of Adam? What tells us this?

10. Obedience (Despite Adversity)

1. The opposite of sin - See also "Works." REF!!
 2. Not everyone who cries “Lord, Lord” - Mt 7:21-23.
 3. Parable of the 2 Sons - Mt 21:28-32.
 4. Those who love Jesus will be - Jn 14:15, 23ff, Rev 22:14.
 5. Acceptance for the obedient without favoritism - Ac 10:34-35.
- See also Gen 4:6-7, Ro 6:16, IITh 1:7-9, Heb 5:8-9, Jas 2:24, IPe 1:22-23, IJn 2:4; 5:3.

Why is the phrase “despite adversity” important?
What do some religions believe about those who are independent & wealthy. What does the Bible say?
In Mt. 21:28-32, what the prodigal a son in the beginning? Does this not indicate someone who is saved or a Child of God? Defend.

11. Judgment

1. God is just and impartial, Ac 10:34-35, Ro 2:19-11, IITh 1:10, IPe 1:17, Rev 19:2.
 2. Everyone will be judged - Ro 14:10b-12.
- See also "Eternal Punishment" Mt 25:31-46, Lk 11:31-32, Ac 17:30-31, IICo 5:10-11, Col 3:25, Heb 9:27, IIPe 2:9.

“Everyone has an eternity. It’s up to you to decide where it will be spent.” Discuss.

12. Eternal Punishment Awaits the Wicked

1. Punishment worse than death: Dan. 12:2, Mt 18:6 & 26:24, Ac 24:14-15, Heb 10:28-29.
 2. Wicked at future judgment: Mt 10:15, Lk 11:31-32.
- See also Mt 10:28, 13:40-42, 25:41-46, Mk 9:43-48, Lk 16:19-31, Rev 14:9-11, 21:8.

Some Jews today claim that heaven and hell are purely “Christian” concepts or contrivances. Can you defend your view?
What would you say is a good follow-up objective with a non-Christian at this point? Have you laid the foundation for further study of salvation, not skipping integral parts of your study?

2. Not everyone - Mt 7:21-23.
3. Parable of the Sower - Mt 13:1-23.

Why will there be few saved? I thought Jesus came to seek and to save the lost! Explain.

23. The Deity of Christ

1. Emmanuel = God with us – Is 7:14, 8:8; Mt 1:23.
2. Gen. 1: - “Let us make man....” Ge 1:26.
3. Elohim in Hebrew is plural - Ge 21:22?
4. Godhead - referred to 3 times in the NT. Ac 14:29, Ro 1:20, Co 2:9.
5. Jesus’ proclamation - “Before Abraham was, I am.” REF!!
6. The Alpha & The Omega. Re 22:13.
7. The root and the offspring of Jesse. Re 22:13.
8. Thomas’ confession of Jesus as Lord and God. Mt 4:10.???
9. Jesus is the incarnation of the eternal logos (Word) - Jn 1:1 & 14.
9. Angels refuse worship - Jd 13:15-16, Re 22:9.

*Can you find these references?

*Note: in the ASV, Ro 1:20 uses the word "divinity."

5. Holy Spirit Baptism - occurred twice:
 1. On Pentecost - to give power to the apostles - Ac 1:8; 2:1-4.
 2. At Cornelius’ house - to show that Gentiles are accepted - Ac 11:15-18; 15:7-8.
6. Paul later wrote that there is now only “One Baptism” - Eph 4:4.
7. Baptism in the name of Christ is water baptism - Ac 2:38, 10:47-48.
8. It is commanded of everyone - Mt 28:19, Mk 16:16.
9. Promised - Lk 24:49.

Does the Holy Spirit dwell us in presence or in person?
Does He dwell in us personally (directly) or representatively (indirectly)?
What does the term metonymy mean? How does it apply to Ac. 2:38?

26. The Church

1. The Church is the “Body of Christ.” Eph 1:22-23, Col 1:18, 24???
 2. There is one body - ICo 12:12-13, Eph 4:4-6, Col 3:15.
 3. “Churches of Christ” - Ro 16:16.
 4. Saved “Added by the Lord” - not voted in - Jn 15:19, Ac 2:47, IIJn 1:9-10.
 5. Religious division is sinful.REF!!
- See also "Division," "Name," Mt 16:18, Eph 5:23-27, Ac 20:28.

27. The Kingdom

1. “At hand” - Mt 3:2.
2. To come in first century “with Power” - Mk 9:1.
3. But “Power” to come with Holy Ghost - Ac 1:8.
4. Happened on the day of Pentecost - Ac 2:1-4.
5. Kingdom in existence in Paul’s day - Col 1:13.
6. It is the Church - Mt 16:18-19.

So, what is the kingdom? Is it an earthly kingdom?
Do these passages support the concept of pre-millennialism? Explain.

1. Salvation - IPe 1:8-9.

2. Upon the first day of the week – REF!!
3. Not the same as the Sabbath – REF!!

Which of the ten has changed?

Note: How fitting and, perhaps merely coincidental, that God created the heavens and the earth in 6 days and rested on the 7th day - Saturday. Now, we are commanded, as the new children (the new Israel) to assemble on the 1st day of the week, Sunday, which was the beginning of creation.

6. For benevolent works - IJn 3:17.
7. On the first day of the week - ICo 16:1-2.
8. Also giving spiritually: Mt 23:23.

What does the church have a right or an obligation for which to use the money? Give examples.

43. The Lord’s Supper/Communion

1. “Upon first day of the week” - Ac 20, (Compare to the Passover, Ex Ch. 11).
The physical manifestation has become a spiritual one.
See also Mt 26:26-28, Jn 6:48-59, ICo 11:23-29.

Why is this sometimes called communion?

What does communion mean? Is this an accurate word?

Ezr 10:1-3, Mt 19:8-9 & 5:31-32, Mk 6:16-18, Lk 16:18, Ro 7:1-3, ICo 7:10-11.

What are the basic views on this issue?

Where does the church stand?

48. Sexual Immorality

1. Includes adultery, lust, fornication, homosexuality, incest, bestiality and rape - Ex 20:14, Dt 22:13-30, 27:20-23, Pr 6:32, Mt 5:28, Ro 1:24 ff, ICo 6:9, Rev 21:8.

Is homosexuality a choice or an orientation? Note the difference in the way this is phrased today.
