Isa 1:16-20

"Wash yourselves, make yourselves clean; remove the evil of your deeds from My sight. Cease to do evil, Learn to do good; seek justice, reprove the ruthless, defend the orphan, plead for the widow. Come now, and let us reason together," says the LORD, "**Though your sins are as scarlet, they will be as white as snow**; though they are red like crimson, they will be like wool. If you consent and obey, you will eat the best of the land; But if you refuse and rebel, you will be devoured by the sword." Truly, the mouth of the LORD has spoken."

SONG - 501 - Though Your Sins Be As Scarlet

Isa 2:2-5

"Now it will come about that in the last days the mountain of the house of the LORD will be established as the chief of the mountains, and will be raised above the hills; and all the nations will stream to it. And many peoples will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; that He may teach us concerning His ways and that we may walk in His paths." **For the law will go forth from Zion and the word of the LORD** from Jerusalem. And He will judge between the nations, and will render decisions for many peoples; and they will hammer their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not lift up sword against nation, and never again will they learn war. Come, house of Jacob, and let us walk in the light of the LORD."

SONG - 625 - Zion's Call

Isa 6:1-10

"In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple. Seraphim stood above Him, each having six wings: with two he covered his face, and with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. And one called out to another and said, "**Holy, Holy, Holy, is the LORD of hosts**, the whole earth is full of His glory." And the foundations of the thresholds trembled at the voice of him who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke. Then I said, "Woe is me, for I am ruined! Because I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips; for my eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts." Then one of the seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs. He touched my mouth {with it} and said, "Behold, this has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven." Then I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, "Whom shall I send, and who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I. Send me!" He said, "Go, and tell this people: "Keep on listening, but do not perceive; keep on looking, but do not understand.' "Render the hearts of this people insensitive, their ears dull, and their eyes dim, otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts, and return and be healed."

SONG – 47 - Holy, Holy, Holy

Isa 9:6-7

"For a child will be born to us, **a son will be given to us**; and the government will rest on His shoulders; and His name will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Eternal Father, **Prince of Peace. There will be no end to the increase of {His} government or of peace.** On the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and righteousness from then on and forevermore. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will accomplish this."

SONG - 761 - Prince Of Peace! Control My Will

Isa 24:14-17

"**They raise their voices, they shout for joy; they cry out from the west concerning the majesty of the LORD.** Therefore glorify the LORD in the east, the name of the LORD, the God of Israel, in the coastlands of the sea. From the ends of the earth we hear songs, "Glory to the Righteous One," but I say, "Woe to me! Woe to me! Alas for me! The treacherous deal treacherously, and the treacherous deal very treacherously." Terror and pit and snare confront you, O inhabitant of the earth."

SONG - 266 - Majesty

Isa 25:1-4

"O LORD, you are my God; I will exalt you, I will give thanks to your name; for you have worked wonders, plans {formed} long ago, with perfect faithfulness. For you have made a city into a heap, a fortified city into a ruin; a palace of strangers is a city no more, it will never be rebuilt. Therefore a strong people will glorify you; cities of ruthless nations will revere you. **For you have been a defense for the helpless, a defense for the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shade from the heat; for the breath of the ruthless is like a {rain} storm {against} a wall.**"

SONG - 807 - Jesus, Lover Of My Soul

Isa 26:1-9

"In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: "We have a strong city; He sets up walls and ramparts for security. Open the gates, that the righteous nation may enter, the one that remains faithful. **The steadfast of mind you will keep in perfect peace, because he trusts in you.** Trust in the LORD forever, for in GOD the LORD, {we have} an everlasting Rock. For He has brought low those who dwell on high, the unassailable city; He lays it low, He lays it low to the ground, He casts it to the dust. The foot will trample it, the feet of the afflicted, the steps of the helpless." The way of the righteous is smooth; O upright One, make the path of the righteous level. Indeed, {while following} the way of your judgments, O LORD, we have waited for you eagerly; your name, even your memory, is the desire of {our} souls."

SONG – 479 - Peace, Perfect Peace

Isa 35:8-10

“A highway will be there, a roadway, and it will be called the Highway of Holiness. The unclean will not travel on it, but it {will} be for him who walks {that} way, and fools will not wander {on it.} No lion will be there, nor will any vicious beast go up on it; these will not be found there. But the redeemed will walk {there} And the ransomed of the LORD will return and **come with joyful shouting to Zion, with everlasting joy** upon their heads. They will find gladness and joy, and sorrow and sighing will flee away.”

SONG - 869 - We're Marching To Zion

Isa 40:10-18

“Behold, the Lord GOD will come with might, with His arm ruling for Him. Behold, His reward is with Him and His recompense before Him. **Like a shepherd He will tend His flock**, in His arm He will gather the lambs and carry {them} in His bosom; He will gently lead the nursing {ewes.} Who has measured the waters in the hollow of His hand, and marked off the heavens by the span, and calculated the dust of the earth by the measure, and weighed the mountains in a balance and the hills in a pair of scales? Who has directed the Spirit of the LORD, or as His counselor has informed Him? With whom did He consult and {who} gave Him understanding? And {who} taught Him in the path of justice and taught Him knowledge and informed Him of the way of understanding? Behold, the nations are like a drop from a bucket, and are regarded as a speck of dust on the scales; behold, He lifts up the islands like fine dust. Even Lebanon is not enough to burn, nor its beasts enough for a burnt offering. All the nations are as nothing before Him, they are regarded by Him as less than nothing and meaningless. To whom then will you liken God? Or what likeness will you compare with Him?”

SONG - 134 - The Lord's My Shepherd

Isa 40:25-31

“To whom then will you liken me that I would be {his} equal?” says the Holy One. Lift up your eyes on high and see who has created these {stars} the One who leads forth their host by number, He calls them all by name; because of the greatness of His might and the strength of {His} power, not one {of them} is missing. Why do you say, O Jacob, and assert, O Israel, "My way is hidden from the LORD, and the justice due me escapes the notice of my God"? Do you not know? Have you not heard? The everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth does not become weary or tired. His understanding is inscrutable. He gives strength to the weary, and to {him who} lacks might He increases power. Though youths grow weary and tired, and vigorous young men stumble badly, **Yet those who wait for the LORD** will gain new strength; **they will mount up {with} wings like eagles**, they will run and not get tired, they will walk and not become weary.”
