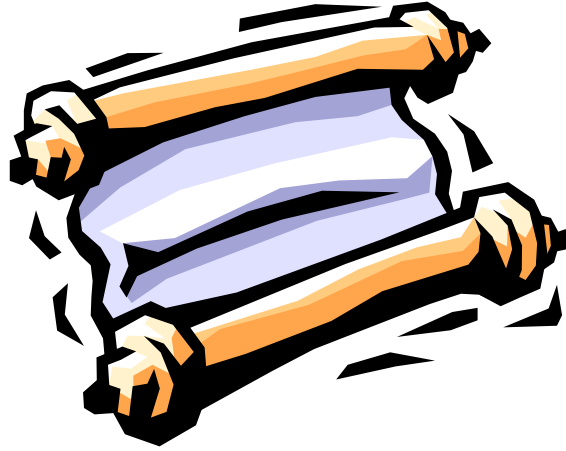


# Isaiah

## PRAYER

Isaiah 41:1-5

"Coastlands, **listen to me in silence, and let the peoples gain new strength; let them come forward** then let them speak; let us come together for judgment. Who has aroused one from the east whom He calls in righteousness to His feet? He delivers up nations before him and subdues kings. He makes them like dust with his sword, as the wind-driven chaff with his bow. He pursues them, passing on in safety, by a way he had not been traversing with his feet. Who has performed and accomplished {it} calling forth the generations from the beginning? 'I, the LORD, am the first, and with the last. I am He.' The coastlands have seen and are afraid; the ends of the earth tremble; **they have drawn near and have come.**"

SONG – 477 - There Is a Place of Quiet Rest

Isaiah 41:10-13

"Do **not fear, for I am with you; do not anxiously look about you, for I am your God.** I will strengthen you, surely I will help you, surely I will uphold you with My righteous right hand.' Behold, all those who are angered at you will be shamed and dishonored; those who contend with you will be as nothing and will perish. You will seek those who quarrel with you, but will not find them, those who war with you will be as nothing and non-existent. For I am the LORD your God, who upholds your right hand, who says to you, "Do not fear, I will help you.'

SONG – 461 – Be Not Dismayed Whate'er Betide

Isaiah 42:6-12

"**I am the LORD, I have called you** in righteousness, **I will also hold you by the hand and watch over you**, and I will appoint you as a covenant to the people, as a light to the nations, To open blind eyes, to bring out prisoners from the dungeon and those who dwell in darkness from the prison. "I am the LORD, that is My name; I will not give My glory to another, nor My praise to graven images. "Behold, the former things have come to pass, now I declare new things; before they spring forth I proclaim {them} to you." Sing to the LORD a new song, {sing} His praise from the end of the earth! You who go down to the sea, and all that is in it. You islands, and those who dwell on them. Let the wilderness and its cities lift up {their voices} the settlements where Kedar inhabits. Let the inhabitants of Sela sing aloud, let them shout for joy from the tops of the mountains. Let them give glory to the LORD and declare His praise in the coastlands."

SONG – 403 – I Hold His Hand

Isaiah 49:13-16

**Shout for joy, O heavens! And rejoice, O earth! Break forth into joyful shouting,** O mountains! For the LORD has comforted His people and will have compassion on His afflicted. But Zion said, "The LORD has forsaken me, and the Lord has forgotten me." "Can a woman forget her nursing child and have no compassion on the son of her womb? Even these may forget, but I will not forget you. "Behold, I have inscribed you on the palms {of My hands;} your walls are continually before me."

SONG - 202 – Joyful, Joyful, We Adore Thee

Isaiah 53:1-6

“Who has believed our message? And to whom has the arm of the LORD been revealed? For He grew up before Him like a tender shoot, and like a root out of parched ground; He has no {stately} form or majesty that we should look upon Him, nor appearance that we should be attracted to Him. He was despised and forsaken of men, a man of sorrows and acquainted with grief; and like one from whom men hide their face He was despised, and we did not esteem Him. **Surely our griefs He himself bore, and our sorrows He carried;** yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But He was pierced through for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the chastening for our well-being {fell} upon Him, and by His scourging we are healed. All of us like sheep have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; but the LORD has caused the iniquity of us all to fall on Him.”

SONG –351 – He Bore It All

Isaiah 53:7-12

“He was oppressed and He was afflicted, yet He did not open His mouth; like a lamb that is led to slaughter, and like a sheep that is silent before its shearers, so He did not open His mouth. By oppression and judgment He was taken away; and as for His generation, who considered that He was cut off out of the land of the living for the transgression of my people, to whom the stroke {was due?} His grave was assigned with wicked men, yet He was with a rich man in His death, because He had done no violence, nor was there any deceit in His mouth. But the LORD was pleased to crush Him, putting {Him} to grief; if He would render himself {as} a guilt offering, He will see {His} offspring, He will prolong {His} days, and the good pleasure of the LORD will prosper in His hand. As a result of the anguish of His soul, He will see {it and} be satisfied; by His knowledge the Righteous One, My Servant, will justify the many, as He will bear their iniquities. Therefore, I will allot Him a portion with the great, and He will divide the booty with the strong; because He poured out himself to death, and was numbered with the transgressors; yet **He himself bore the sin of many, and interceded for the transgressors.**”

SONG – 922 – Jesus Paid It All

Isaiah 64:5-9

“You meet him who rejoices in doing righteousness, who remembers you in your ways. Behold, you were angry, for we sinned, {we continued} in them a long time; and shall we be saved? For all of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous deeds are like a filthy garment; and all of us wither like a leaf, and our iniquities, like the wind, take us away. There is no one who calls on your name, who arouses himself to take hold of you; for you have hidden your face from us and have delivered us into the power of our iniquities. But now, **O LORD, you are our Father, we are the clay, and you our potter; and all of us are the work of your hand.** Do not be angry beyond measure, O LORD, nor remember iniquity forever; behold, look now, all of us are your people.”

SONG – 552 – Have Thine Own Way

Isaiah 65:14-19

**"Behold, My servants will shout joyfully with a glad heart,** but you will cry out with a heavy heart, and you will wail with a broken spirit. "You will leave your name for a curse to My chosen ones, and the Lord GOD will slay you. But My servants will be called by another name. "Because he who is blessed in the earth will be blessed by the God of truth; and he who swears in the earth will swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hidden from My sight! "For behold, I create new heavens and a new earth; and the former things will not be remembered or come to mind. "But be glad and rejoice forever in what I create; for behold, I create Jerusalem {for} rejoicing and her people {for} gladness. "I will also rejoice in Jerusalem and be glad in My people; and there will no longer be heard in her the voice of weeping and the sound of crying."
